Safety Checks to be done by delivery company before leaving to site.

1.	All delivery vehicles must be roadworthy and have a valid license disk, tires in good condition all lights in working condition and no oil leaks.	
2.	The driver must be in possession of a valid driver's license	
3.	Seat belts (3 point inertia reels) are required	
4.	When height of load exceeds 1.8m, the truck is to be fitted with a secure life line	
5.	The load is to be stacked in and secured a manner so as to allow for safe transportation and off-loading on site	
6.	The equipment supplier and transporting agent are to ensure that the road agency statutory requirements are met (height clearances at bridges and overhead lines, load width and axle loading etc.)	
7.	If drivers/assistants are to off load or load, a risk assessment must be conducted and documented.	
	PPE and Vehicle requirements that to be adhered too:	
	• Safety boots with metatarsal guards	
	• Gloves	
	• Hard hats	
	• Reflective vests	
	• Long sleeves	
	• Safety glasses	
	• Fire Extinguishers 9 Kgs	
	• Tri Angles	
	• All vehicles to have stop blocks	
	• Tie Downs if used in good condition	
8.	Risk assessments need to be submitted and approved if the delivery contractor will be doing his own off-loading.
